In the said letter of the Inquiry Officer dated 06.04.2022 addressed to the Director (Inquiry), Manipur Lokayukta, it is stated that the collection of material, information and documents has been carried out and also the spot inspection of works/projects in the village of Ukhrul District by the Technical team with the Inquiry Officer has also been carried out but the preparation of Technical Report and recording of statements of the respondents cannot be completed within the extended period. It is also further submitted that the inquiry is extended for further two months w.e.f. 12.03.2022.
	4. Considering the works site to be inspected is situated at far flung area of Ukhrul District and also the difficulties of recording the statements of all the respondents and others, it appears that it would be just and appropriate to extend the period of inquiry by another 70 days w.e.f. 12.03.2022.
