- 1. Perused the office note dated 13.06.2022, wherein it is indicated that Director (Inquiry), Manipur Lokayukta under his letter dated 13.06.2022 to the Chairperson, Manipur Lokayukta had required to extend the period for completion of preliminary inquiry for another 3 (three) months w.e.f. 12.06.2022. We have also perused the letter of the Inquiry Officer dated 10.06.2022 to the Director (Inquiry), Manipur Lokayukta.
