NOTE AND ORDER

- 1. Respondent Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16,17,18,19 and 21 had filed the joint objections/comments against the Preliminary Inquiry Report submitted by the Inquiry Officer Shri Shankar, Addl. SP.
- 2. Mr. Juno Rahmans, Learned counsel stated that Respondent Nos. 11 & 13 had engaged he and his chamber colleagues as their counsels and further prayed for one week's time for filing separate comments/objections on behalf of the Respondent Nos. 11 and 13 to the Preliminary Inquiry Report submitted by the Inquiry Officer.
- 3. Mr. A. Arunkumar Singh, Learned counsel appearing for all the Respondents has no objections to the engagement of Mr. Juno Rahman and his chamber colleagues as counsels for the respondent Nos. 11 & 13 by filing vakalatnama.
- 4. Mr. L. Savananda Sharma, Learned counsel appearing for the complainant raised objections to the prayer of Mr. Juno Rahmans who entered appearance on behalf of the Respondent No. 11 & 13 on the ground that the proceeding of the present case will be delayed because of such arrangement amongst the respondents.
- 5. After taking into consideration of all the submissions made by the learned counsels, it would be appropriate to give at least one week's time to the respondent No. 11 & 13 to file their separate/joint objections/comments to the Preliminary Inquiry Report subject to the payment of Rs. 4000/- as costs to the complainant. The respondent Nos. 11 & 13 could file their comments/objections only after payment of the said costs to the complainant.
- 6. List this case for filing of the comments/ objections of the respondent Nos. 11 and 13 and also for further hearing on 6-10-2021.
