## **COMPLAINT CASE NO. 3 OF 2021**

## 02.12.2022

- 1. Complainant appeared in person.
- 2. Mr. S. Dijeswar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf Mr. M. Gunedhor, conducting counsel for respondent nos. 1 and 2 submits that he has already paid the cost of Rs. 2000/- for adjournment imposed earlier to the complainant in the court itself. Today also, he submits at bar that the conducting counsel of respondent nos. 1 and 2, Mr. Gunedhor is now at Delhi for medical treatment of his near relative, therefore, he prays for adjournment of the present case.
- 3. Prayer for adjournment is objected by the complainant. Complainant said that he is coming from far flung hill area of the hill district of Tamenglong and for coming to Imphal for his appearance before Manipur Lokayukta in connection with the present case, he has to stay at least one day at Imphal and thus has to bear all the expenses for coming to Imphal and also the rent of the hotel.
- 4. Such being the situation, prayer for adjournment, as last chance, is granted subject to payment of Rs. 5000/- as cost which shall be paid to the complainant on or before the next date of hearing.
- 5. It is made clear that if Mr. Gunedhor, conducting counsel for the respondent nos. 1 and 2 if not available on the next date of hearing, the respondent nos. 1 and 2 shall have to make an alternative arrangement/alternative counsel for conducting their case.
- 6. List this case on 21.12.2022 for hearing.
